KS1 Clubs for the Spring Term 2017 - Year 1 and Year 2

This term we are pleased to offer a wide range of clubs once again. The information about ALL the clubs for **Year 1 and Year 2** is included in this one letter, which you can keep for reference.

Clubs will start the week commencing **23 January 2017** with the exception of Karate, which starts on the 10 January.

Some clubs **are fully funded by the school**, so are completely free to you.


We will offer a reduction in the cost of non sports based clubs for children eligible for Free School Meals/Pupil Premium (not Universal Infant Free Schools Meals). If you are eligible and wish to benefit from this, please pop in and see us.

You and your child should decide which clubs they would like to do and fill in the return slip at the end of this letter. We will then allocate places and may need to draw names from a hat if clubs are over-subscribed. Once places have been allocated, we will let you know which club your child is in.

You can pay by cash or cheque (made payable to Southampton City Council). Alternatively, details will be available online (once places have been allocated) and this is a convenient way to make your payment. (If you need help to set up an online account, please call in at the office.) **All payments must be made before the start of the club. If we haven't received payment before the first day of the club, your child will not be able to take part.**

Please return the permission slip to the office by **Monday 9 January 2017**. We will let you know club allocations for children by **Monday 16 January**.
