KS1 Clubs for the Autumn Term 2018 - Year 1 and Year 2

This term we are pleased to offer a wide range of clubs once again. The information about ALL the clubs for **Year 1 and Year 2** is included in this one letter, which you can keep for reference.

Clubs will start the week commencing **1 October 2018** with the exception of Karate, which started on the 11 September and Drumming Club which starts on the 19 September.

Some clubs **are fully funded by the school**, so are completely free to you.

We will offer a reduction in the cost of non sports based clubs for children eligible for Free School Meals/Pupil Premium (not Universal Infant Free Schools Meals). If you are eligible and wish to benefit from this, please pop in and see us.

You and your child should decide which clubs they would like to do and then fill in this [online form](#). We will then allocate places and may need to draw names from a hat if clubs are over-subscribed. Once places have been allocated, we will let you know which club your child is in.

Once places have been allocated, details will be available for you to pay online. This is a quick and easy way to make your payment. Alternatively, you can pay by cash or cheque made payable to Southampton City Council. (If you need help to set up an online account, please call in at the office.) All payments must be made before the start of the club. If we haven't received payment before the first day of the club, your child will not be able to take part and we will call you to collect your child.
