





## Year 4 Curriculum Bulletin

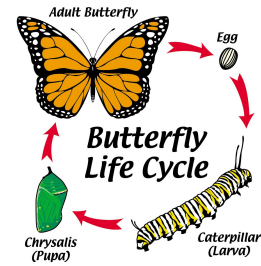
### Spring 2: Changes

<p><b>English</b></p>	
<p><b>Speaking and Listening</b></p>	
<p>To begin our English this half term we will be looking at playscripts. We will perform both existing playscripts, as well as playscripts which we have created.</p>	
<p><b>Reading</b></p>	
<p>We will continue to be exploring a range of different texts this half term, to extend our reading skills as well as support our writing. We will be looking at existing playscripts and diaries to inform our writing. In our Reading lessons, we will be focussing on inference skills.</p>	
<p><b>Writing</b></p>	
<p>To kick start our writing this half term, we will be creating our own playscripts which we will then perform. We will then explore different characters using diary writing.</p>	

<p><b>Maths</b></p>	
<p>Our focus in lessons in this half-term will be applying our understanding of shape to other areas of maths - calculating area and perimeter, completing shapes on a coordinates grid and investigating patterns.</p> <p>As with last half term, this term we are having a big focus on our times tables. As well as working on these in school, it is really important for children to spend time rehearsing these at home too.</p>	

## Science

We will be looking at how humans and other animals experience life cycles, including how their bodies change as they get older.



## Topic/Other Subjects

- Our Topic this half-term is changes. Much of this topic will be explored through our science focus of life cycles.
- In PSHE we will be discussing growing up and puberty.



## PE

This term, in our teacher PE we will be dance.

This term TMC PE lessons will normally be on Thursdays and teacher PE lessons will normally be on Tuesdays.
