










Year 1 Curriculum Bulletin

Autumn 2 : Toys

<p>English</p>	
<p>Speaking and Listening</p> <p>This term the role play area will be transformed into a toy shop. This is to coincide with our topic with term all about toys. There will be old and new toys for the children to play with and some activities available to support their learning.</p> <p>The last three weeks of term the role play will be transformed into a winter postoffice where the children will be allowed to wrap parcels, write letters and work with money.</p> <p>The children will also be learning and reciting firework poems.</p>	
<p>Reading</p> <p>Our class book for this half term is: 'A Bear Called Paddington' by Michael Bond</p> <p>Daily practise of reading and writing words in Phonic lessons. Useful games include Phonics Play, Spelling games and Deep Sea Phonics.</p> <p>We also work on guided reading activities daily.</p>

We will be writing labels, poems, recounts, stories, letters and lost posters.</p>
