Year 3 – Oakthorne Trip to Woodmill Activity Centre – 5 April 2017

We have been busy planning some fun, educational activities for the 'Oakthorne' children.

On **Wednesday 5 April** we have arranged for all children to visit Woodmill Activity Centre. The children will participate in **land-based activities only** which include archery, climbing and a low ropes/tunnelling course. This is a fantastic opportunity for the children!

Children will need a packed lunch and a drink in a carton or a plastic drinks bottle. **No cans please.** If your child is entitled to a free school meal, we will provide a packed lunch from the school kitchen. As always, please make sure that if your child needs medication e.g. asthma inhaler, that they bring it with them on those days.

Children do not need to wear school uniform for this visit. All children will need to wear clothes suitable for outdoor activities. We suggest that they wear track suit bottoms and trainers. They will also need to wear a long-sleeved top as this is essential for some of the activities. They may get dirty and therefore we advise that they should not wear clothes that are precious or valuable. **Please make sure that your child brings a warm coat with them.**

In order for the visit to take place, we are asking for a contribution of **£10** per child. If we do not receive sufficient contributions to cover the cost, it may be necessary for us to cancel this activity. Should you have any difficulties with regard to this contribution, please do not hesitate to contact the School Office. **Please remember you may pay online for this trip.** We would be grateful if all slips could be returned by **31 March 2017.**

All children will be taking part in a range of practical activities, including cookery. The children will be eating what they cook, so if your child has any food allergies or medical conditions, please let the school office know. Children do not need to wear school uniform for this day, but please make sure they are in sensible, practical clothing.

We do like to give children who remain at school during residential visits a comparable experience and I think that the activities we have arranged will do that and will be thoroughly enjoyed by the children.
