Construction of Year R Shelter

You may be aware that we were recently awarded a Big Lottery Fund grant of just under £10,000 to build a new shelter for Year R children outside their base.

This will mean that children can be learning outside even if it's raining, and it will provide some shade in the summer.

**Construction will take place next week,
Tuesday 21 – Friday 24 March.**



This means that the part of the playground directly between the Year R base and the rear of the site will be closed, and some other parts of the playground will be shut off with fencing.

All Year R children will go in and out of the base from the Yellow doors which lead towards the KS2 playground. There will be no access around the outside of the building from the main KS1 playground to Year R. Access will be by the main "crossover" doors in the linkway, or round by the KS2 playground.

We hope that you can bear with us for a few days while this exciting new project takes shape! Your children will soon be making the most of using the new shelter!

All children will use the Yellow doors in the morning and the afternoon during construction.

(Tuesday – Friday)



The doors by the steps will not be used during construction.



The gates into the main Year R playground will be closed.



There will be no way round the back of the building – to get to the Yellow Year R doors you will need to go through the linkway crossover doors, or round by the KS2 playground.



The gate to the rear of the site leading to Chilworth Drive (the path between the school and the field) will be closed.
