Residential Visit to Fairthorne Manor –25/26 April 2019

I am pleased to be able to offer **Year 3 children** the opportunity to visit Fairthorne Manor in April 2019.

Last year the Year 3 children had an amazing time at Fairthorne. As a result we wanted to offer the new Year 3 children the same experience for 2019.

The children will leave school at approximately **10.15 on Thursday 25 April** and return on **Friday afternoon** at around **3.00pm**. They will be sleeping at the Manor for only one evening but will have **two days** of fun packed and challenging activities, which we know will develop self-confidence and team building. These activities will include **activities such as aerial runway, canoeing, obstacle course, archery and the climbing wall**. In the evening the children will enjoy an outdoor campfire and team games.

The total cost for this trip will be **£95.00**. The full cost of this visit must be paid by **Friday 8 March 2019**.

Please complete the slip at the end of this letter and return it **by Friday 5 October 2018** together with a **£35 non-refundable** deposit.

On receipt of the deposit we will issue payment cards. To avoid the need to make one large payment we are asking that regular payments are made, as follows:

Payment 1	-	£20 by 30 November 2018
Payment 2	-	£20 by 1 February 2019
Final Payment	-	£20 by 8 March 2019

Obviously, if you would like to pay the full balance for the trip before the required date you can do so.

I would like to point out that once a child has returned the form with the deposit **this is a firm commitment** and refunds will not be possible as the school pays the full balance at a very early stage. Please therefore, consider very carefully if you want to commit your child to a




place. Should there be medical reasons why a child cannot attend, the school's journey insurance can be used.
