Active Nation TRYathlon Event – 10 June 2015

For the third year running we have been inspiring our children with a sports based initiative, our 'Club of the Month' programme, to encourage our children to join local clubs, take part in sport and have fun being active. We have had a range of local clubs into school for a day and your child has had a go at something new each month. Just search 'Club of the Month' on our school blog to find out more.

Our June Club of the Month day will be an all day event. We have secured places for every KS2 child at the **ActiveNation TRYathlon event at the Southampton Outdoor Sport Centre on Wednesday 10 June.**

The day will include a range of taster sessions delivered by local clubs and coaches and this year's activities include tobogganing, cricket, netball, ultimate frisbee, dodge ball, ringos, archery, tennis, golf and hockey to name a few. Each class will take part in a range of activities, however due to time restrictions will not take part in all those listed.

ActiveNation, as well as local news channels and papers will be taking photos/videos of the event on the day. If you do not want your child to be photographed/videoed then please let the school know, in writing, so they can inform the leisure centre.

The cost of this year's event will again be funded by the school's Sport Premium Funding so is free to all children. As such all children are expected to attend.

Children will need to:

- Enter school as soon as they arrive, so we have sufficient time register all children before leaving at 9:10.
- Bring a packed lunch and a drink.
- Come to school in clothing appropriate for sporting activities (shorts, t-shirt, trainers). They will need a long sleeved top and tracksuit bottoms for all



activities taking place on the ski slope, although additional overalls will be provided for participants taking part in activities on the slope.

- Wear sun cream, and a hat if the weather is warm, or water proof clothing if we experience wet conditions.

If your child is eligible for free school meals we will provide them with a packed lunch.

Children will be walking to the Sports Centre with staff from Oakwood after registration and will return to school for the end of normal school day.

Thank you for your continued support and we hope that your child enjoys taking part in these amazing activities.
