

	<p><u>Cause and Consequence</u></p> <p>Can give simple explanations why a person from the past acted as they did and talk about the consequences of those actions.</p>
	<p><u>Historical Enquiry</u></p> <p>Can talk about similarities and differences between two or more historical sources using simple historical terms.</p> <p>Can talk about past events and use annotations or captions (maybe scribed) to identify important features of picture sources, artefacts etc.</p>
