<b>Voyage</b>	A trip somewhere.

<b>Consequence</b>	The changes that happen as the result of an event. What happens afterwards.
<b>Iceberg</b>	A large piece of ice that is floating in the sea.
<b>Port</b>	A town or city where ships can load and unload people or cargo.
