

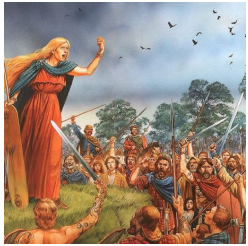

Boudicca	Boudicca was a Celtic queen who is famous for rising up against the Roman occupation in AD60 or 61.

Romans	The Romans are the people who originated from the city of Rome in modern day Italy.
Empire	A group of territories or people under one ruler .
Britain	Great Britain is the largest island in Europe. It contains England, Scotland, and Wales.
