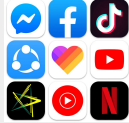
### Key Words

<b>technology</b>	The ideas used to make devices (electronic objects) which help us.

<b>website</b>	A page that anyone can access using the internet.
<b>username</b>	An online identification (which should not contain personal information).
<b>personal information</b>	Information that can tell people about our real life.
