As an Artist, what do I already know from previous learning?

I have used a range of painting tools to experiment with mark making e.g. brushes, sponges, tissue, fabric, string

I have played with colours and experimented to 'discover' new colours.

I know that colours can be made darker or lighter by adding black or white or by adding more water/pigment.







Key Vocabularly	
Figurative	Art work which looks like real life.
Horizontal Line	A line which runs left-to-right across a page.
Impressionism	The 'impression' of what the person, object, light or place looked like, rather than what it exactly looked like.
Post Impressionism	An art movement that came from impressionism where artwork was created to express the artists thoughts or feelings.
Landscape	Natural scenery
Tone	The lightness or darkness of something.
