Key Words

panel	A box containing one small part of the story.
speech bubble	A white shape used to show what characters are saying.
sticker words	These are added to show sound effects.
scale	A tool which allows you to change the size of items.
flip	A tool which allows you to reverse items.
arrange	A tool allowing you to drag items to a new position.

Our Learning Steps

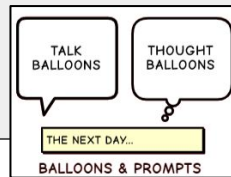
1. Backgrounds and Characters
