Key Words

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editing	Selecting and preparing your film clips.
shot size	How near the characters are to the camera - from close up to wide.
overdub	Adding recorded sound to replace the sound in a film clip.
take	A filmed segment. Sometimes more than one take is needed to avoid mistakes.
trim	When you shorten a clip at the start or the end.
split	Break one video clip into two pieces.

- I can create a film using stop-motion.

1. Editing

I will use editing software to select, sequence and trim video clips.



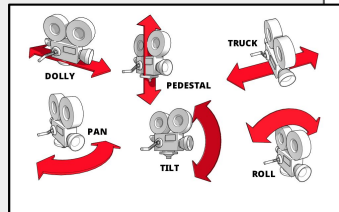
2. Sound Editing

I will add music, sound effects and overdub dialogue to change atmosphere.



3. Filming

4. Storyboard

I will plan my shot list and camera movements for my scene.



5. Film Making

I will record a story using more than one shot.
