

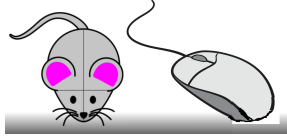

Key Words

mouse	We can control the computer by moving the mouse with our hand or clicking the buttons.
cursor	The arrow on screen that moves when we move the mouse with our hand.
key	A button on a keyboard.
keyboard	The part of a computer we use to press letters and spaces.
touch-screen	Phones and tablets don't use a mouse or keyboard because they have a screen you can tap.

Our Learning Steps

1. Click the target

I will learn to click on points using the mouse and the cursor.



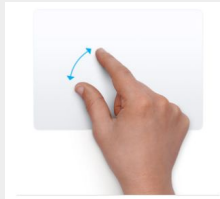
2. Click and drag

3. Touch screen
