



Year 3 Comic Creation Using IT

Key Words Panel A comic is divided into panels, which are the scenes of the story **Narration** Tells the story in words. Stickers These can be added to the panels to show effects, such as a bang or visual sound effect. Scale Change the size of an object. **Arrange** Put the objects in front or behind each other (e.g a character in front of background) Flip Turn an object, such as a character, to face the other way

4. Panels


Know how to add, resize, organise characters/objects to different panels.
