Key Words	
Clips	Small parts of a video or pictures that make up one overall video
Timelines	The timeline is where we place the clips in an order to make a whole video.
Split	We can split a clip into smaller parts, such as removing the middle of a clip.
Transitions	Add different effects that go between the clips, such as swiping across or spinning
Titles	Add text to the clips, such as giving more information. You can choose the position, size and colour of the text.

What do I already know?

- 1. Add and edit backgrounds.
- 2. Add and edit characters, including changing posture, expression and clothing.
- 3. Add narration and speech bubbles, including formatting text.
- 4. Duplicate objects to match scenes.
- 5. Search for objects to use.



Our Learning Steps

1. Scene images

I will learn how to use an image search to add an image on **Kapwing**.

2. Voiceovers and cropping

Write a short script as a welcome to your video and what it will be about. Then watch this video to learn how to add a voiceover using the **Vocaroo** website, adjust the volume and crop the clips so they match up.

3. Transition effects

Learn how to add another image scene and VoiceOver, then experiment with transition animation effects.

4. Titles

Learn how to add titles to your clips so that viewers can get extra information.

5. Elements

Use the elements tool to add objects such as shapes to point at parts of the video you are talking about in your voiceover.

6. Background music and exporting

Learn how to add music to your project and adjust the volume so that it does not get in the way of your voice over. Export your finished project.
