Model- —a practise version so that you can test out your ideas.

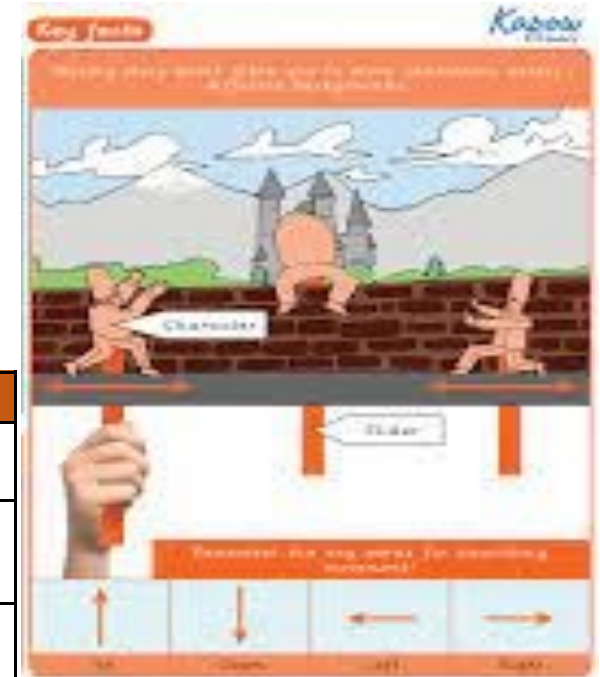
